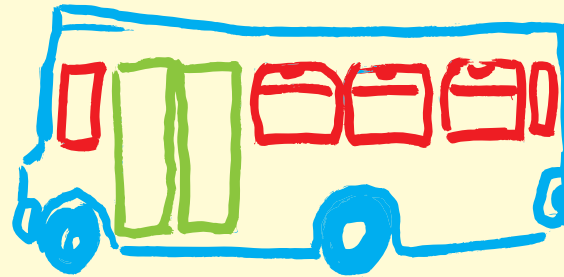

# 2 Waiting for the bus

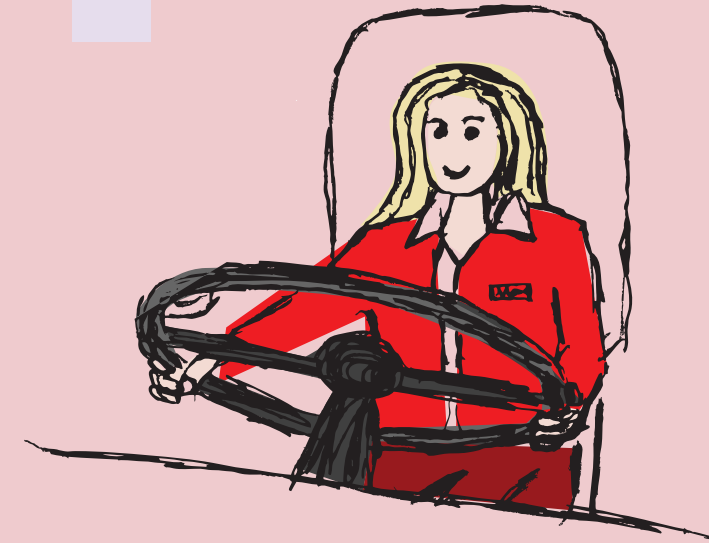
When you wait for the bus stand on the pavement well back from the traffic. It is dangerous to play around. Wait until the bus has stopped before you try to get on.
