- Water stations will be available on all routes.
- Volunteer marshals (with mobile phones), the St John Ambulance and a bicycle repair and recovery service, kindly provided by Ralph Colman Cycles, will be on hand to assist riders.
- Medals will be awarded to all riders completing their chosen course.
- The Genesis Centre building will be open at the end of the ride to provide refreshment for all cyclists, their family and friends.
