### SILK MILLS TO TOWN CENTRE

#### Mondays to Fridays

First departures 0640, 0705 and 0730 then every 7 minutes until 0930 then every 12 minutes until 1540. From 1549 every 7 minutes until 1802 with last departures at 1816, 1846 and 1916.

#### Saturdays

First departure 0730 then every 12 minutes until 1804.

### TOWN CENTRE TO SILK MILLS

#### Mondays to Fridays

First departures 0652, 0717 and 0742 then every 7 minutes until 0937 then every 12 minutes until 1549 then every 7 minutes until 1806 then 1815 with last departures at 1830, 1900 and 1930 operating via Musgrove Park Hospital.

#### Saturdays

First departure 0742 then every 12 minutes until 1823.

£1.20 Child Day Return (age 5-15 inclusive)

£5.00 Group Ticket

Valid for up to 5 people travelling in the same car, who must travel together on both journeys.

£8.00 Weekly Ticket

Valid for one week's travel. Please note there are no Park & Ride services on Sundays and Public Holidays.

£10.00 Flexirider Multi-Journey Ticket

Gives 12 single journeys which must be used within one month of purchase.

£28.00 Calendar Monthly Ticket

Valid for one month's travel. Please note there are no Park & Ride services on Sundays and Public Holidays.

£280.00 Annual Season Ticket

Only available by calling 0845 345 9155.

Tickets are valid for use at either Park & Ride site.

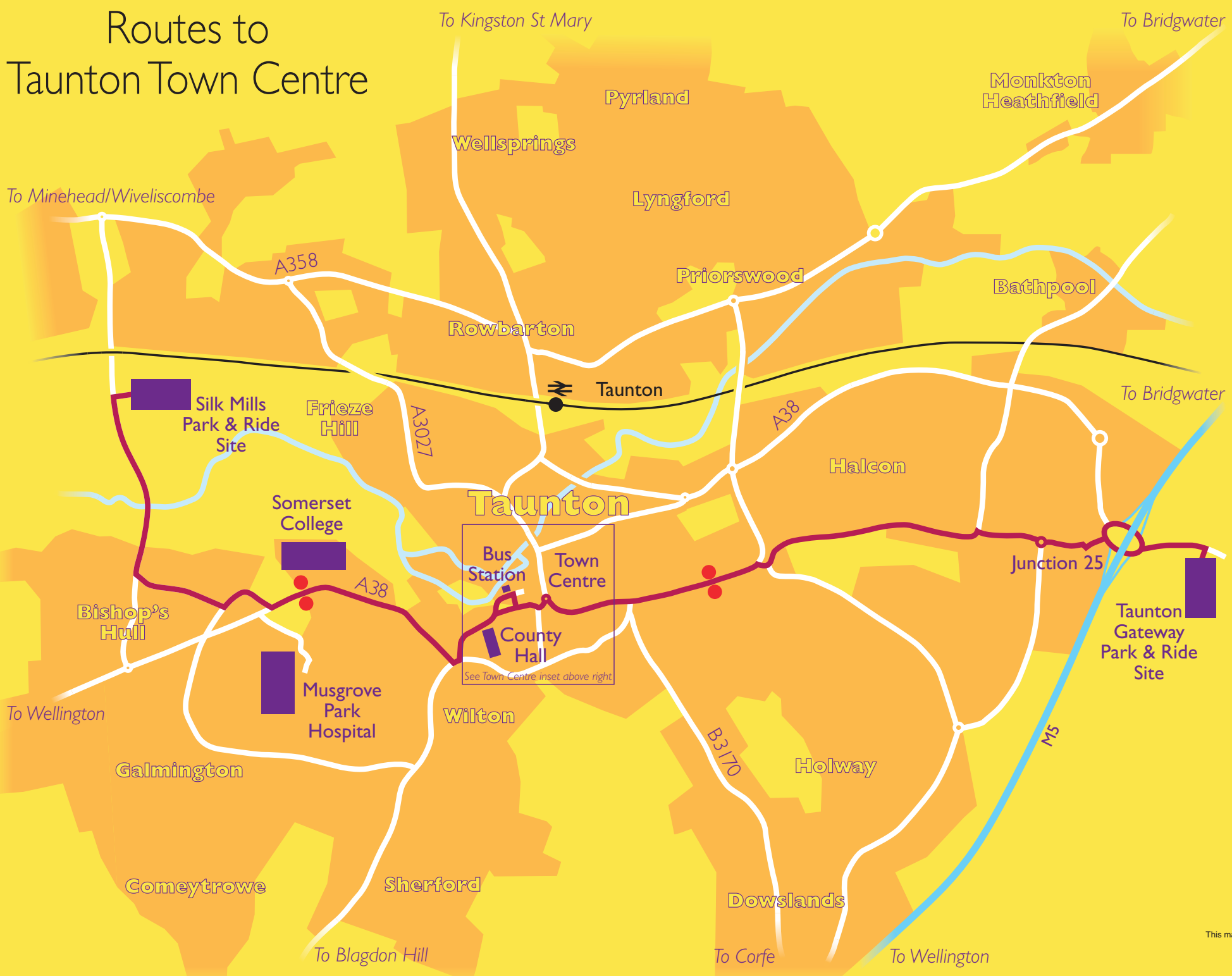

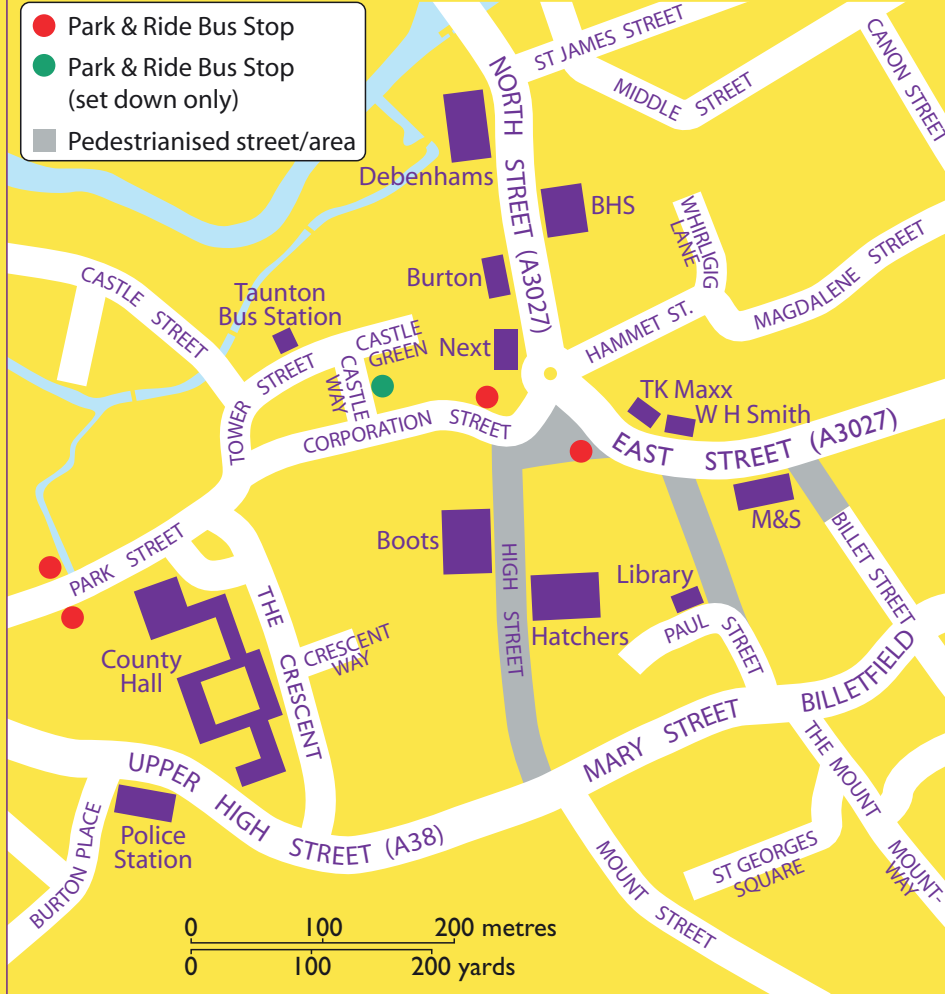
